#### 79<sup>th</sup> Texas Legislative Session: Bills Filed with Infection Control Content

- The table below are bills filed with infection control content that may impact the progress/purpose of infection control programs in Texas. Out of 240 bills filed with the words “disease” or “infection” we are currently tracking sixteen.
- Friday March 11, 2005: Deadline for filing bills and joint resolutions other than local bills, emergency appropriations, and bills that have been declared an emergency by the governor. Last day for House Committees to report House Bills is Monday 05/09/05. Last day for Senate Committees (?) to report Senate Bills is 05/17/05 or 05/18/05.
