1/26/2023	Recent data show Evusheld is unlikely to be active against certain SARS-CoV-2 variants, which are responsible for 90% of current COVID-19 infections. The F.D.A. is no longer authorizing its use in the U.S.
1/11/2023	A joint CDC/FDA investigation has identified seven linked cases of sepsis after transfusion from bacterially contaminated platelet blood products since 2018. The cases occurred in multiple states and genetic testing of isolates by the CDC found with high probability that the organisms were related and had a potential common source. Read the FDA safety alert and CDC guidance on preventing sepsis.
1/4/2023	The FDA is providing additional information about two recent issues in certain reworked Philips Respironics (Philips) Trilogy 100 and Trilogy 200 ventilators. These Philips Trilogy 100 and Trilogy 200 ventilators were recalled in June 2021 for issues with the polyester-based polyurethane (PE-PUR) sound abatement foam breakdown.
