N. meningitis: CDC HAN 3/2024 Increase in Invasive Serogroup Y Meningococcal Disease in the United States. Please report all suspected or confirmed cases to the local health dept.

<u>Novel Influenza A:</u> DSHS HAN reporting the first human case of novel avian influenza A (H5N1) in Texas. Please report any suspected novel avian influenza A (H5N1) cases to the local health dept. immediately.

<u>Burkholderia multivorans</u>: CDC is working with state and local health departments to investigate infections due to *B. multivorans* in multiple jurisdictions following potential exposure to nonsterile ice and water from ice machines during clinical care activities
