 - b. Surveillance question and survey presentation- Jennifer Adams **Surveillance questions/responses** reviewed with the group. Jennifer demonstrated the use of the HAI calculator.
 - c. Public Health Update: Thi Dang
 - ARLN Initiative Antibiotic Resistance Lab Network started in 2016. State of Texas
 with the Austin and Houston labs can assist in determining if isolates can be better
 identified in outbreaks. ARLN also allows for voluntary submission of isolates for
 CRE testing (this is separate from what is being currently reported)
 - MCR-1: 1st Detection in Texas this gene increases resistance potentially being very difficult to treat. Need good follow-up and communication between facilities
 - Avian Influenze suspected US cases but none confirmed to date. Requires standard/airborne precautions. Screen for travel within last 10 days.
 - There is no longer an HAI Epidemiologist in Austin contact Thi Dang if questions 817-264-4541/4587
