6/6/2019	The CDC is expecting a three to ten month nationwide shortage of APLISOL®, a product of Par Pharmaceuticals. APLISOL® is one of two purified-protein derivative (PPD) tuberculin antigens that are licensed by the FDA for use in performing tuberculin skin tests
6/20/2019	The FDA announced that Infusion Options Inc. is voluntarily recalling all lots of all sterile products within expiry to the hospital level. These products are being recalled due to a lack of assurance of sterility. Read the FDA safety alert.
6/19/2019	The FDA is directing healthcare providers to conduct donor screening and MDRO testing of donor stool to protect patients from transmission of life-threatening infections from use of fecal microbiota for transplantation (FMT). Read the FDA safety alert.
