




Cases & Deaths among Healthcare Personnel

Data were collected from 1,642,455 people, but healthcare personnel status was only available for 339,722 (20.7%) people. For the 71,949 cases of COVID-19 among healthcare personnel, death status was only available for 42,386 (58.9%).









Texas COVID-19 Daily Cases & Fatalities












Positivity Rate Texas








DFW COVID-19 Positive Cases

 - 2. For suspected patients: how are you documenting them in your EMR? If a patient is on COVID19 Isolation Precaution orders but has a negative test result, are you counting them as suspected?

The Three C's


Clean your hands!
