How to Submit

To submit an abstract, go to the APIC-DFW web page and click on the Call for Abstracts submission link to complete the online form. Please have your Abstract available to transpose into the Microsoft Forms questionnaire. The submitting author must provide a valid e-mail address, as APIC will rely exclusively on e-mail communications related to abstract submission, disposition, and presentation.

Schedule

3/7/2024 Call for Abstracts submission site opens

5/5/2024 Submission deadline for abstracts (11:45 pm CST).

8/1/2024 Poster Presentations – Dallas, Texas (include physical location?)

Requirements

- 1. All acronyms and/or abbreviations must be spelled out or defined at first use, even those considered common by the submitters
- 2. Abstracts should include Title, Background, Methods, Results, and Conclusion.
- 3. Abstracts must be written in complete sentences in a narrative format, do not include bulleted lists, tables, or figures.
- 4. Proofread the abstract for typographical and grammatical errors. Use grammar and/or spell check.
- 5. Abstracts should not be used to market products.
- 6. Abstracts should not contain any brand names, commercial influence, or promotional material.
