- 8. Public Health Update (Diana Cervantes, Epidemiologist with TxDSHS)
 - a. Ebola TDSHS continues to monitor individuals returning from West Africa; most are low risk. There are 14 Ebola Assessment facilities in Region 2/3.
 - b. Measles <u>There were 10 cases of measles in Texas in 2014. There has been one case in 2015 in</u> <u>Tarrant County. The cases have occurred in individuals who were under-immunized, non-immunized, or had travel history.</u>
 - c. CIC for Epidemiologists <u>TDSHS is advocating for increased standardization of CIC</u> requirements for state health epidemiologists. Currently epis may take the CIC without any experience in the field.
