- 9. Public Health Update (Diana Cervantes, Epidemiologist with TxDSHS)
 - a. <u>MERS update- Diana explained the Hajj Pilgrimage will be occurring towards the end of the</u> month around September 21-26th in Saudi Arabia and MERS cases are expected to increase.
 - b. <u>Arboviral 'season' is winding down however providers should remain vigilant for</u> <u>Chikungunya. Signs & symptoms of Chikungunya include fever, rash and joint/muscle pain.</u> <u>There are currently no locally acquired cases however there are travel related cases from</u> <u>Africa, the Caribbean, Mexico, and South/Central America. Dallas County can provide a</u> <u>Chikungunya PCR but it sample must be collected within 5 days of symptom onset.</u>
